

1. 先祷告：（求天父帮助自己安静和专注）

2. 读经文： **以赛亚书 第41章**

3. 想一想：（★主要思考建议）

- ★ 本章呼吁众民来做辩论（1节），这东方来的强权，他的权力都是从神而来（2~4节）。但人却转向自己的力量，以为稳固（5~7节）！神始终会帮助以色列民（8~16节），假神也全属虚无（21~29节）！在这样的裁判中，你会站在哪一方？我们知道耶和華是至高的真神，但神要人与祂辩论，即不少人在实际生活上反而倚靠地上的权力或偶像。我们可有用心去分辨？
- 神对祂子民的看顾，让胆怯的不害怕（8~13节），使卑微的得改变（14~16节），供应穷乏干渴者所需（17~20节）！我们真认识这位如此爱我们的神？

4. 读经文： **以赛亚书 第42章**

5. 参 考：

- 「我的仆人」在圣经中有时是指以色列民族（四十一8、9，四十四1），有时可指一个神给予特殊任务的使者（民十二7，十四24）。以赛亚多指民族，而本章可指一人（1~7节），或指民族（19节），但有些也可有双重引喻。

6. 想一想：（★主要思考建议）

- ★ 耶和華责备以色列，他们像耳聋眼瞎（18~20节），不领会神的话语，不明白神的律法其实是显明祂的公义（21节），因他们不肯遵行神的道，不听从祂的训诲（24节）！今天我们觉得神的话语难明，会否因为我们没有立志遵行？

9. 金句（或本章要点）_____

1.Pray: (Heavenly Father, please quiet my heart and focus my mind)

2.Read:

Isaiah Chapter 41

3.Ponder: (★key point to ponder)

- ★ This chapter calls all the people to a debate (v. 1). This strong power from the east received his power from God (v. 2-4). But humanity turned to their own strength, thinking they are secure (v. 5-7). God would eventually help the Israelites (v. 8-16); all idols were nothing (v. 21-29). In this adjudication, which side would you take? We know that the Lord is the true God in the Highest, but God wants people to debate with Him, as many people actually rely on worldly strength or idols in their lives. Can we discern with our heart?
- God cares for His people, encourages those who fear (v. 8-13), transforms the humble ones (v. 14-16) and provides for the poor and needy (v. 17-20)! Do we really know this God who loves us so much?

4.Read:

Isaiah Chapter 42

5.Reference:

- “My servant” in the Bible sometimes refers to the nation of Israel (v. 41:8-9; 44:1); at other times, it represents an envoy to whom God assigned special missions (Nu 12:7, 14:24). Although Isaiah most likely referred it to the nation of Israel, in this chapter, the term can be referred to either a person (v. 1-7) or a nation (v. 19). However, in some cases, it may carry both meanings.

6.Ponder: (★key point to ponder)

- ★ The Lord rebuked Israel as deaf and blind (v. 18-20). They did not understand God’s Word or how God’s Law revealed His righteousness (v. 21), simply because they did not follow God’s ways or obey God’s Law (v. 24). Today, if we think God’s Word is hard to understand, would it be because we are not determined to obey Him?
